Notice of Race

1. Venue

The Royal Alfred Yacht Club takes pleasure in inviting you to compete in the Bloomsday Regatta which will be held on June 19th 2010 under the Burgee of the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, in association with the Dun Laoghaire waterfront Yacht Clubs. The Race Office will be in the National Yacht Club.

2. Rules.

This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. In the event of any conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instruction shall prevail.

3. Classes

The Championship will be held for the following classes. Cruiser Classes 0,1,2,3,4 & White Sails, J109, Laser SB3, Dragon, Sigma 33, Beneteau 31.7, Ruffian, Puppeteer, Glen & Shipman.

4. Category.

ISAF Regulation 20 will apply. Class rules limiting the display of advertising will apply.

5. Entries.

Boats shall enter only in writing by completing and signing the official entry form, available from the club website www.rayc.ie. The Entry fee is as per the entry form. Entries should be mailed to the Secretary, Royal Alfred Yacht Club, PO Box 7512, Dun Laoghaire, Co Dublin. **All competitors are granted temporary membership of the RAYC for the duration of the Regatta.**

7. Sailing Instructions

Copies of the Sailing Instructions may be left in the Yacht Club designated on the entry form and also will be available in the Race Office NYC 8hrs30-11hrs00 Friday 1800 2000 Sat .

8. Scoring

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. Penalties

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for Course C only.

10. Insurance

Each Boat's owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons. Boats or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain sufficient 3rd party insurance cover. All Owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

11. Liability

No responsibility shall be accepted by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, or any of the associated yacht clubs, their directors, officers, members servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the event, for any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature, however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Regatta

12. Responsibility

The safety of the Boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge whose obligation it is to ensure that the Boat is fully sound, seaworthy and is manned by an experienced crew with all the required safety gear. Neither either this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions nor any action by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club its Organising Committee in any way limits the responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge. Attention is drawn to RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rules.

13. Prizes

1st, 2nd & 3rd prizes will be presented for each class racing.

IRC & Echo prizes will be presented for Cruisers 1,2,3 handicap classes.
